YO LA TENGO I Am Not Afraid of You and I Will Beat Your Ass (Matador) When three dorky, guitar-slinging indie-dorks think they can beat your ass, you've clearly made some poor choices in your life.

GIRL TALK NIGHT Ripper (Illegal Art) This album plus people equals instant hipster soirée.
Mashes up all of your fav indie classics with mainstream hiphop for an album you can dance to, or cross your arms and enjoy ironically. Fun for everyone!


